2017 Year End Award Nomination Form Procedure

Requirements for Year End Award Participation:

Adults 18 & over: Volunteer 12 total hours at horse shows and other NWSC Activities

Youth 11 – 17: Volunteer 12 total hours at horse shows and other NWSC Activities

Youth 10 & under: 2 – 4 hours encouraged ~*Recommend working with a parent, club member or family member.*

Note: Family/friend can work up to half of the hours needed for the youth. The hours worked must be indicated that they are working for the youth on the sign-in sheet at time of event/activity. NO retroactive time given.

- The Award period runs from November 1, 2016 to October 31, 2017.
- Awards will be given according to points earned at NWSC Horse Shows only. First tie-breaker shall be total volunteer hours. Second tie-breaker shall be number of meetings attended. Third tie-breaker shall be a coin toss.
- Nomination is for Horse/Rider/Division Combination only.
- Points DO NOT count until the form is turned in with correct payment. \$10 before April meeting and \$15 after April meeting.
- Anyone wishing to be eligible for year end awards must complete and submit a nomination form listing horse and rider combinations. You must be a member in good standing with dues paid to start receiving points and you must be a member in good standing at the end of the point/hour year to receive award.
- Nomination forms must be turned in by the April meeting to receive the discounted rate. All nomination forms received after that meeting will be full price.
- This is NOT the North Metro Association year end nomination form.

It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to make sure all points, hours and division information is accurately recorded by October 31st. NO EXCEPTIONS.

It is encouraged to sign up early for desired hours and positions. If all volunteer shifts are full, and you did not sign up, there may not be an open volunteer opportunity for you at that time.

****BONUS TIME for those that volunteer at shows:** For a rider that has been showing all day or a working volunteer, you have the opportunity to earn an extra hour toward your required hours by being active in the clean-up at the end of a show.

****You must be present when the show chair says the clean-up is done for bonus credit.****

All volunteer hours are subject for review by NWSC show chairs and activity coordinators.
